Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church Spring 2010 Skyline Student Parking Permit Application

Applications will not be accepted without all required documentation completed and attached**

SKYLINE Students who park on Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church property for the purpose of school commuting, must have a valid SHLC Student Parking Permit. Students will be assigned a **specific parking stall** that coincides with the permit number. Space is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis. In exchange for the parking privilege, **Skyline Students** agree to provide **2 hours** of community service through Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church per semester. **Spring semester hours are due by May 28, 2010 to be eligible to apply for a parking spot for the fall 2010 semester.** Please note that Skyline Students do **not** qualify as **Commuters** as defined by King County *Park & Rideshare*.

2. Agreement and Waiver forms must be signed and attached
3. **Attach** one copy each of: student's drivers license, valid automobile registration for EACH auto student will be driving and proof of valid automobile insurance policy for EACH auto student will be driving.

Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church Skyline High School Student Parking Regulations

What is Student Parking?

Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church welcomes the opportunity to share its facilities with the community. We are, therefore, pleased to offer Skyline High School students the privilege of parking at Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church for school commuting. *Space is limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis until all permits are assigned.*

Please note that Skyline students are **not** commuters, as defined by *King County Park & Rideshare*. Skyline students, who wish to park at Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church for school commuting purposes, must apply for a **SHLC Student Parking Permit**. Permits are available for fall and spring semesters; application is required for **each semester**. Students who are issued a Parking Permit are required to provide **2 hours** of community service through Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church per semester. **Spring service hours are due by May 28, 2010.**

Beginning **February 3, 2010**, applications will be accepted in the Church Office (on Feb. 3 ONLY, the office will open at 8 am. Normal office hours are Mon – Fri; 8:30 am – 4:00 pm), 22818 SE 8th Street, Sammamish for SPRING semester parking permits. Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. All required information and supporting documents **must** be submitted with the application. Applications that are missing required documentation will be returned to the student for completion and the student will be placed at the end of the application waiting line.

SHLC STUDENT PARKING POLICIES:

- Student must maintain **current** information on file with SHLC. Changes must be submitted, **in writing within 1 week**, to the Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church office (i.e.- addition of car; change in personal information or insurance provider).
- **Each Permit assigns a specific vehicle to a specific parking stall. Students may not provide their Parking Permit to another student.**
- Parking Permit grants students the privilege to park in the Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church parking lot in the **student parking area** (see map) during school hours.
- SHLC Student Parking Permit **must be face up and clearly visible** through the **front window** of the car. If it is not clearly visible, a warning will be issued. Repeat violators may have their car towed at the owner's expense.
- If the license number of the car does not match the license number of the permit, a warning will be issued. Repeat violators may have their car towed at the owner's expense.
- Students may park **only** in their assigned parking stall. Parking anywhere else on the Sammamish Hills lot will result a warning. Repeat violations will result in the forfeiture of parking privileges at the church and the student declared ineligible for parking on the Skyline campus **for the remainder of their time at Skyline High School.**
- Students assume responsibility for keeping the area around their vehicle clean. Any paper, restaurant or food debris found near their vehicle will be considered a **first offense**. (**Note:** All cars parked **near** the debris will be tagged with a warning.) A **second offense** may result in the revocation of the SHLC Student Parking Permit and/or towing of vehicle at the owner's expense.
- Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church does not assume responsibility for property theft or damage to vehicles. Student must report theft, accident, or vandalism to local law enforcement authorities.
- Lost permits may be replaced for \$20. A lost permit must be reported to the SHLC Office without delay.
- Church officials are neither qualified nor trained to assist students in gaining access to their car or in its maintenance.

- Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church reserves the right to temporarily suspend parking privileges when a church event requires full use of the parking lot. Should such an occasion arise, SHLC will place a written notice on the windshield in advance.

DRIVING ON OR ABOUT SAMMAMISH HILLS LUTHERAN CHURCH PROPERTY:

- Obey all Washington State traffic laws; failure to do so may result in immediate revocation of the SHLC Student Parking Permit.
- The speed limit in the church parking lot is **10 MPH** and will be strictly enforced.
- Obey all entrance, exit and directional markings.
- Speeding, reckless driving, or endangerment in the SHLC parking lot or on adjacent streets may result in revocation of the SHLC Parking Permit and citation by local law enforcement authorities.
- Parking without the assigned SHLC Student Parking Permit is subject to towing at the owner's expense.
- Violation of the rules will result in a student warning, possible revocation of permit and/or towing of vehicle at the owner's expense.

COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS MAY BE COMPLETED THROUGH ONE OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS:

- One of two group options to be announced by **mid-March**;
- A community service project approved by staff of Sammamish Hills. If you are unable to attend either group project, **IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to schedule your own service project with a staff member of Sammamish Hills. This must be done independent of other class/extracurricular requirements (i.e. National Honor Society or Key Club). **Spring hours are due by May 28, 2010 to be eligible for fall 2010 parking privileges.**

CONSEQUENCES OF MISUSE OR ABUSE OF SHLC PARKING PRIVILEGES:

As previously stated, the potential consequences for violation of the rules established by this agreement include the revocation of your parking permit, revocation of any future parking privileges at either Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church or Skyline High School, towing of your vehicle at your expense, and a citation issued by the Sammamish Police Department. In other words, the congregation is happy to share the lot with you, but, this is a privilege, which, if abused, has serious consequences.

Student Parking Permit Agreement
