Meet God!

What does a meeting with God really look like? Is meeting with God as obvious as a burning bush, or waking up to a voice calling your name? Maybe a meeting with God a simple affair—sitting in your comfiest chair, praying, and then a feeling of acceptance or love. In 1 Kings, God is described not as a strong wind, earthquake, or roaring fire—but as sheer silence. Or is it a disruption of the life you knew pushing you to grow into a life you never would have dreamed of? If we are going to grow in relationship with God, we need to first see where we meet God. We need to see where God shows up.

VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

COUNSELORS IN TRAINING (CITS) are 11th & 12th graders (space permitting) who seek to improve their leadership skills as part of staff. On occasion, CITS are invited to be counselors based on space & experience.

COUNSELORS are students entering, in, or just beyond college. Counselors work with a group of middle school students for the weekend, leading their cabin through daily activities.

GUIDES are adults who are 25 & over who lead a small group twice a day while at camp. Being a guide offers plenty of free time to take advantage of the surroundings. Guides sometimes share their time and talents in leading discovery centers—like running, crafts, or whatever your hobby is!

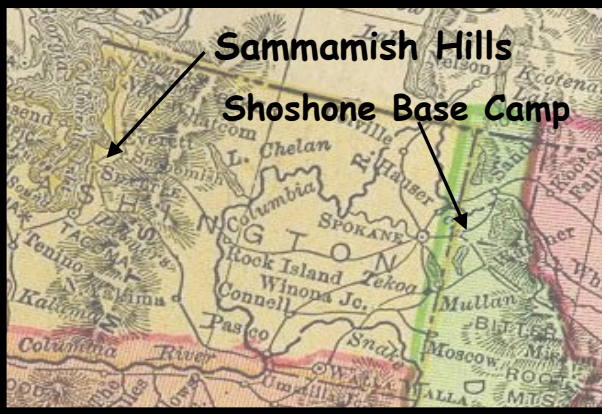

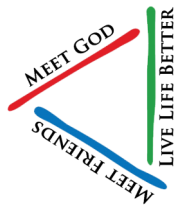
