INTRODUCTION

Welcome to Sammamish Hills Lutheran Church! We are a people gathered by God from all over East King County to share life under the cross, and a congregation of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (www.elca.org). What follows is a brief introduction to some of the many ways we seek to be a people and place where others can “meet friends, meet God, and live life better.”

WORSHIP

The central focus of our life together is found in regular and robust Sunday worship, turning from whatever commands and compels our attention in daily living and offering our whole selves—time, talents, and treasures—to God.

ALL ARE WELCOME IN WORSHIP. PERIOD. Undergirding this welcome are a variety of aids and experiences for every season of life. Parents (and grandparents, guardians, etc.) with young children have three options: bringing your child to church with you; utilizing the Cry Room on the SW side of the sanctuary; or leaving your child in the Nursery located in the sanctuary basement. If you choose to bring your young child to worship, there are specially marked pews which have extra room for young souls to play.

For those with limited eyesight or hearing, there is a hearing-impaired system and large print bulletins. Just ask one of the ushers.

WORSHIP TIMES AND STYLES Sunday mornings we have both a liturgical service at 9:00 a.m., and an informal service at 10:30 a.m. The 9:00 a.m. service is led by cantors, choir, organ and piano, and the traditional hymnody of the Lutheran Church. The 10:30 service is led by various worship bands, all coordinated by our Worship Coordinator Trev Wilson. The pastors preach and preside at both services.

It takes a lifetime to form a disciple of Christ and so we are engaged in lifelong learning. Here’s who to contact for each age in life:

SERVICE

The members of Sammamish Hills are involved in a broad range of outreach ministries both locally and globally. These include the Day of Service and the Ministry of the Month. Ministries of the Month include local food banks, counseling services, camping associations, educational ministries, and more. On the annual Day of Service we send over three hundred folks out to at least twelve different ministry sites throughout East King County, and it is one exciting day!

CARE

The Care Team responds to a broad range of crises and celebrations across the lifespan from cradle to grave.
